Or from the QR code to download.</p>  <p>Compatible devices: For iOS: iPhone 4S, iPhone 5S, iPhone 6S/6S Plus, iPhone 7, iPhone 8, iPhone X and newer. For Android: Samsung S10/S10+, Samsung Note 10/10+, Huawei P30/P30 Pro/S10, Vivo, OPPO and others with Android 5.0 or newer. iOS 9.0 & Android 4.4 or supported.</p> <p>Download on the App Store GET IT ON Google Play</p>	<p>STEP 2:</p> <p>Turn on Bluetooth.</p>  <p>When this option is on, the tracker and phone will beep when tracker is moved. But they only alert once in every 90 seconds to avoid continuous disturb.</p> <p>STEP 3:</p> <p>Sign up for New User</p>  <p>Start "iTrackEasy" App and tap the "Sign Up".</p> <p>STEP 4:</p> <p>Pair the iTrack to Your Phone</p>  <p>1) Make sure to turn on your phone's Bluetooth. 2) Hold the iTrack device close to your phone. 3) Hold the button on the iTrack until you hear a beep and the LED starts flashing.</p>	<p>Motion Alert:</p>  <p>When this option is on, the tracker and phone will beep when tracker is moved. But they only alert once in every 90 seconds to avoid continuous disturb.</p> <p>Motion History:</p>  <p>You can get the recent motion history when the device is connected with phone.</p> <p>Item Finder & Phone Finder:</p>  <p>When the device and phone are connected, you can use the device to find your phone, or use your phone to find the device.</p>	<p>Separation Alarm:</p>  <p>When the phone and device are out of range both phone and device will make sound alert.</p> <p>Last Seen location:</p>  <p>The App will record the last disconnection location in the map.</p> <p>Mark as Lost:</p>  <p>If you lost your item, our iTrack network may help to find.</p> <p>When the device is "Mark as Lost", it will disconnect location signal. When other iTrack user passes by and open the location signal, the GPS location will be sent to you.</p>	<p>Camera Remote:</p>  <p>The button on the device also doubles as a camera remote.
